## BEHAVIOR TECHNICIAN ANCILLARY SCHOOL SUPPORT

The behavior technician (BT) is physically in the home to facilitate school-directed instruction and services. By having one representative facilitate all learning modalities, students with disabilities can receive quality educational services while reducing unnecessary risk of exposure to COVID-19.

### Ancillary School Services Supported

- Curriculum learning (Directed by Teacher)
- Speech language pathology (Directed by Speech Therapist)
- Physical therapy (Directed by Physical Therapist)
- Occupational therapy (Directed by Occupational Therapist)
- Adapted physical education (Directed by Physical Education Teacher)
- Behavior management (Directed by Board-Certified Behavior Analyst or Psychologist)

### How a Behavior Technician Helps

- Ensures attendance to online learning activities
- Establishes routines
- Responds to challenging behavior
- Dictates writing
- Provides socialization
- Trains communication tools
- Reads to students
- Runs gross motor exercises
- Facilitates tests
- Conducts study sessions
- Delivers learning prompts
- Guides worksheets

### Qualifications and Training

Behavior technicians receive 40 hours of training and education centered on supportive services in the home environment. They must pass an exam prior to working in the field and qualify for RBT/BCAT certification and CPI certification, if applicable. BTs attend all trainings put forth by the school.

### Other Behavior Technician Responsibilities

- Collect and report documentation of academic progress
- Collaborate daily/weekly with school professionals through telecommunication
- Spend time reviewing lesson plans, preparing materials, and grading completed work
- Set up and clean up based on sanitization protocol
- Track attendance in partnership with district's remote attendance protocol

### Reducing Exposure to COVID-19

- Daily symptom self-checks for behavior technicians
- Social distancing from parents/family members in the home
- Washing hands, surfaces, materials at the beginning and end of every shift
